

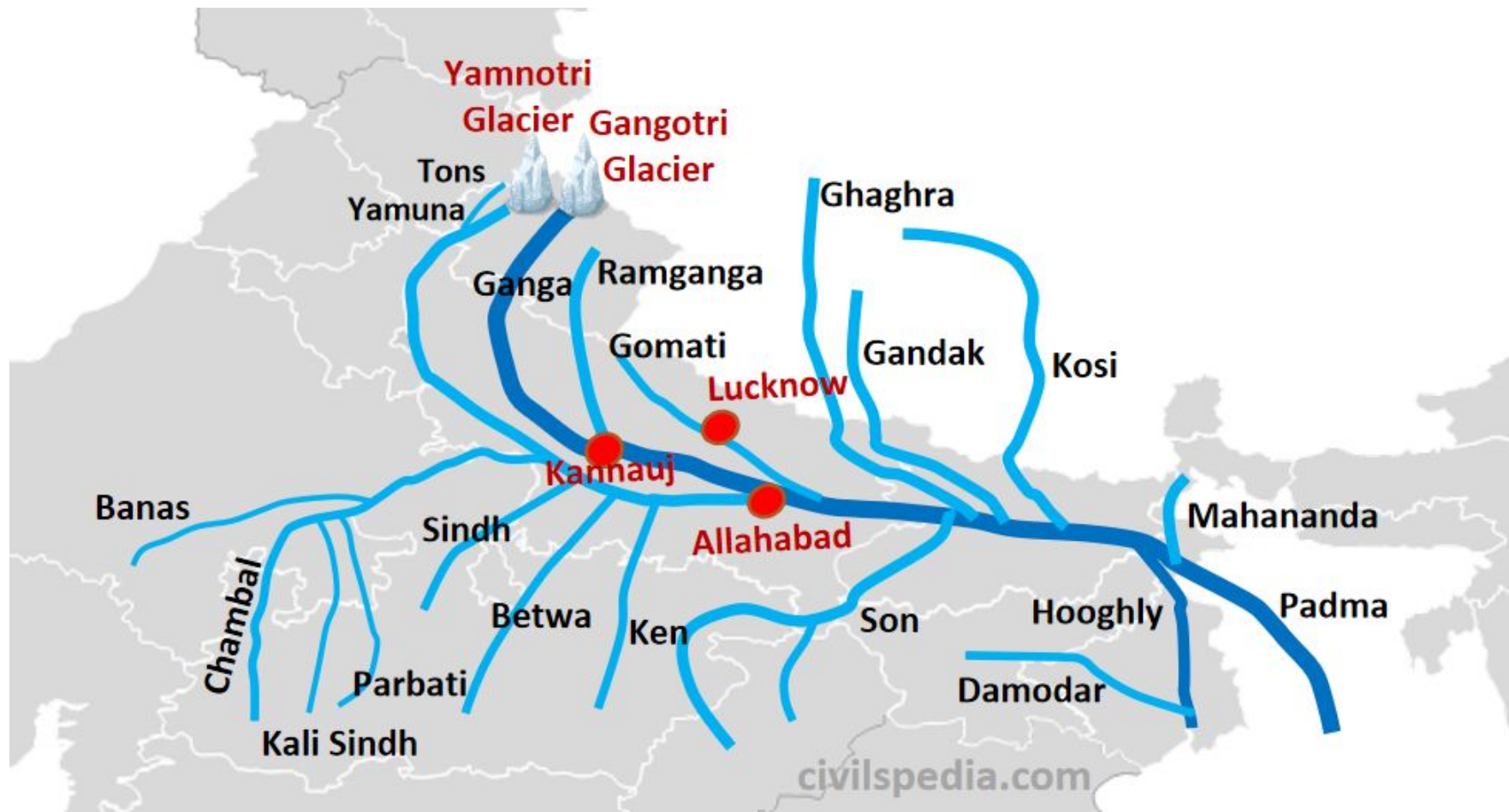

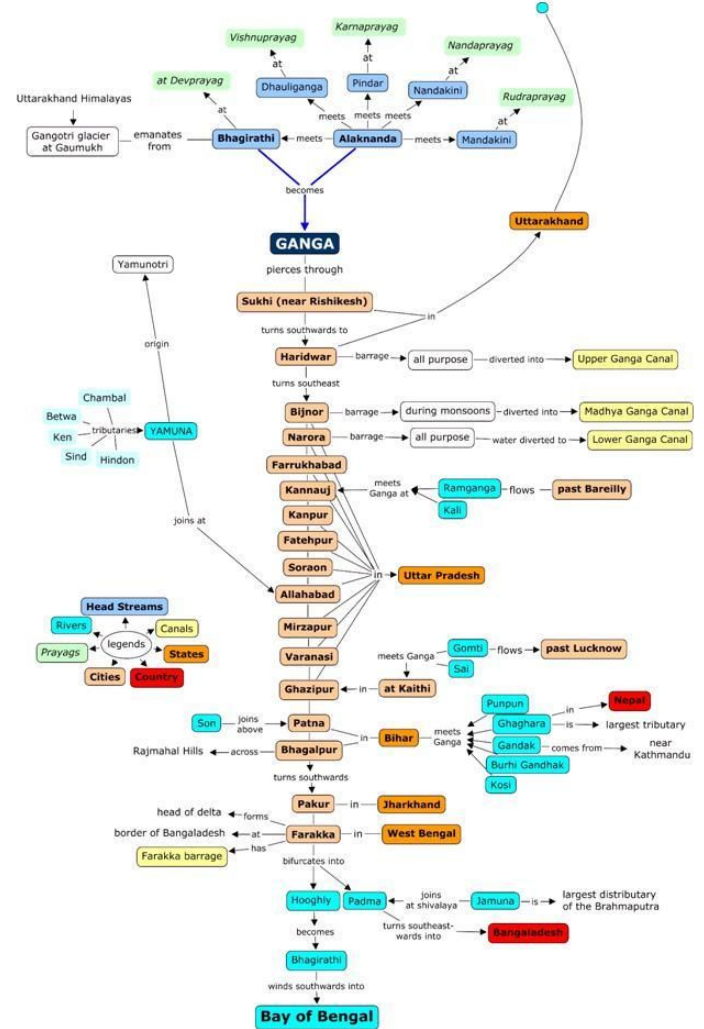

The river Ganga originates from Himalaya. The river is known by over 108 names. A few names under Uttarakhand region is sketched below.

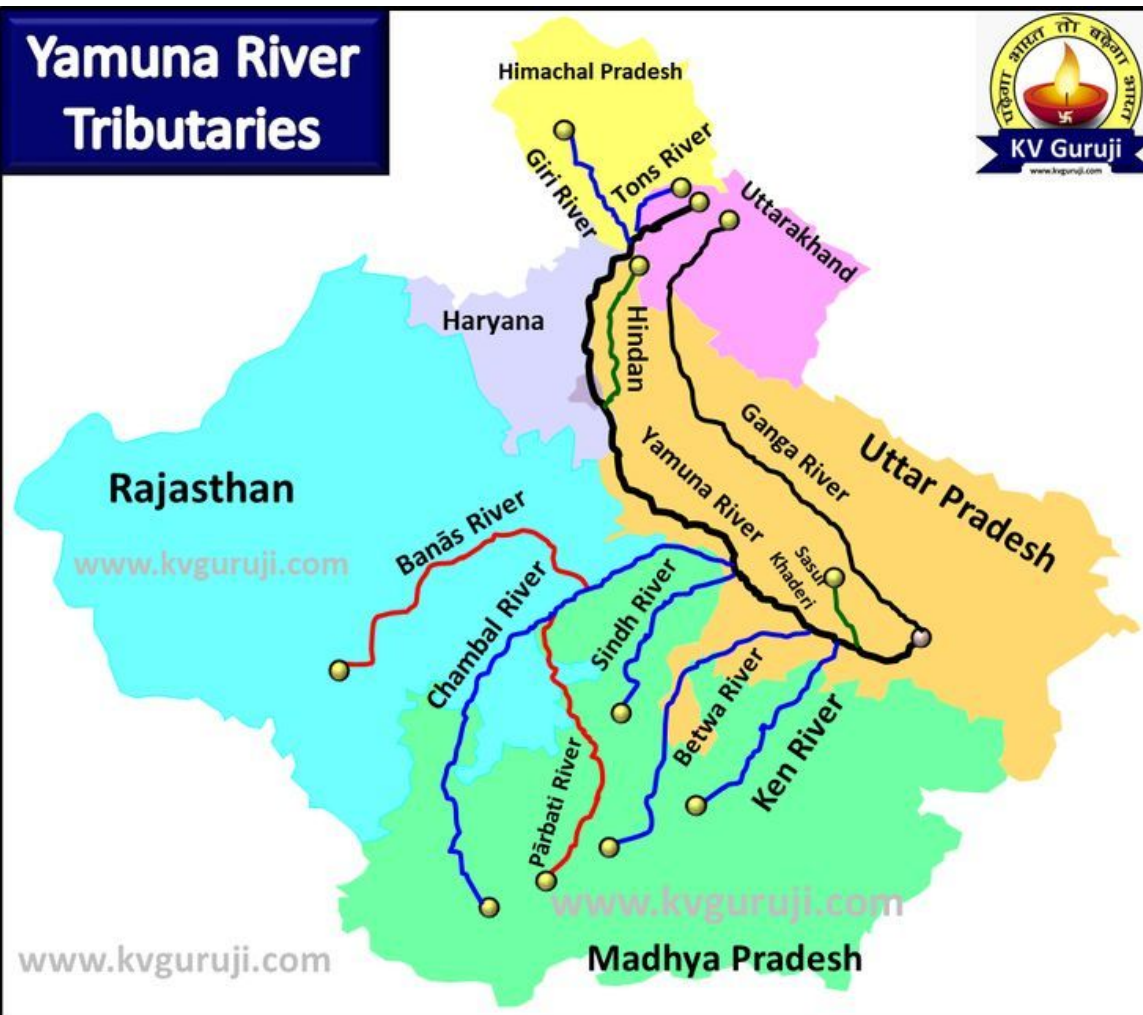


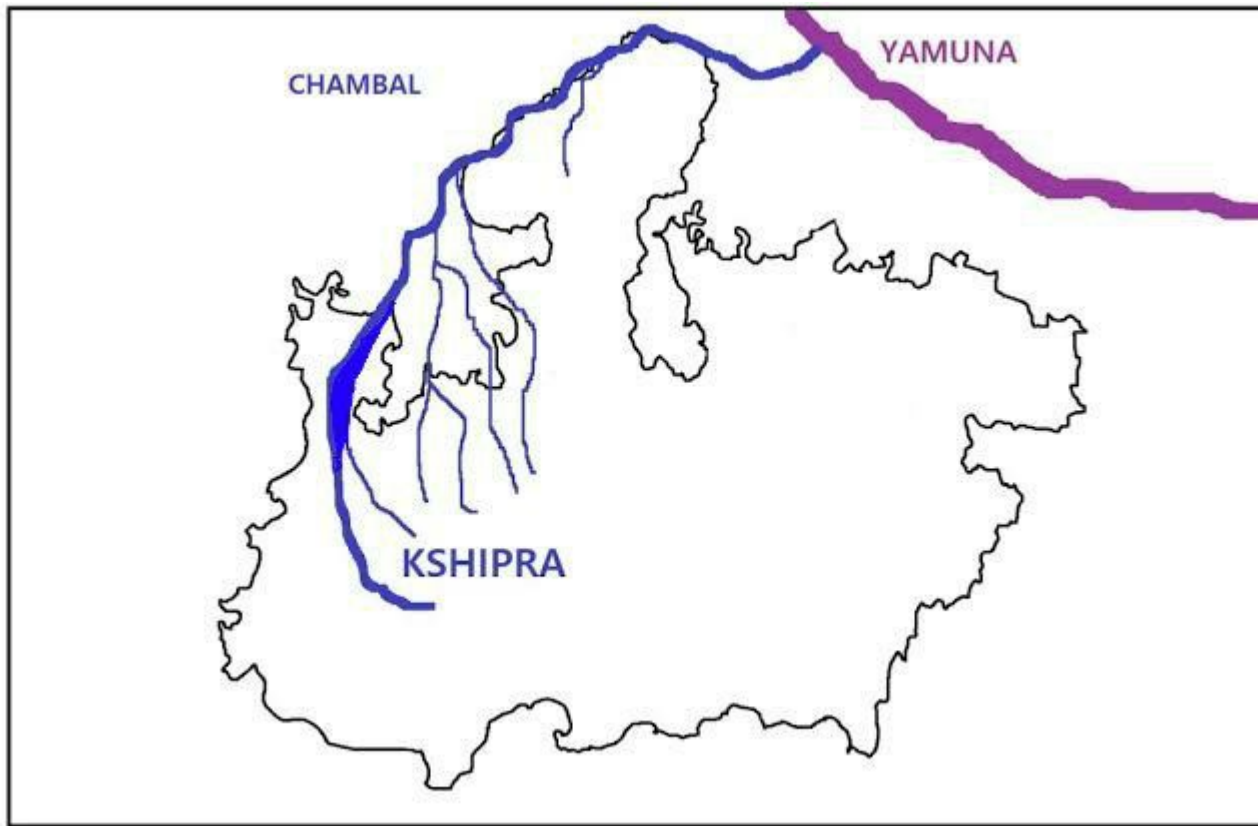

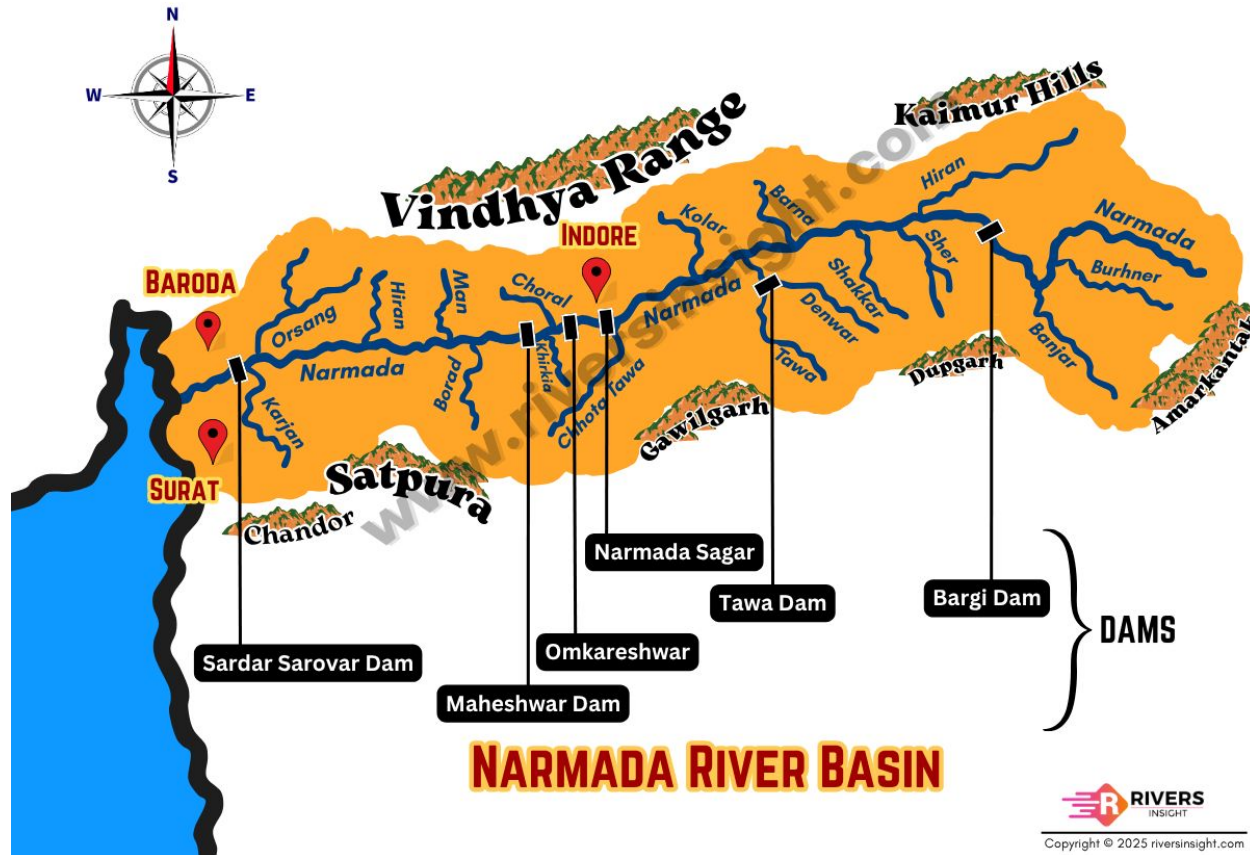

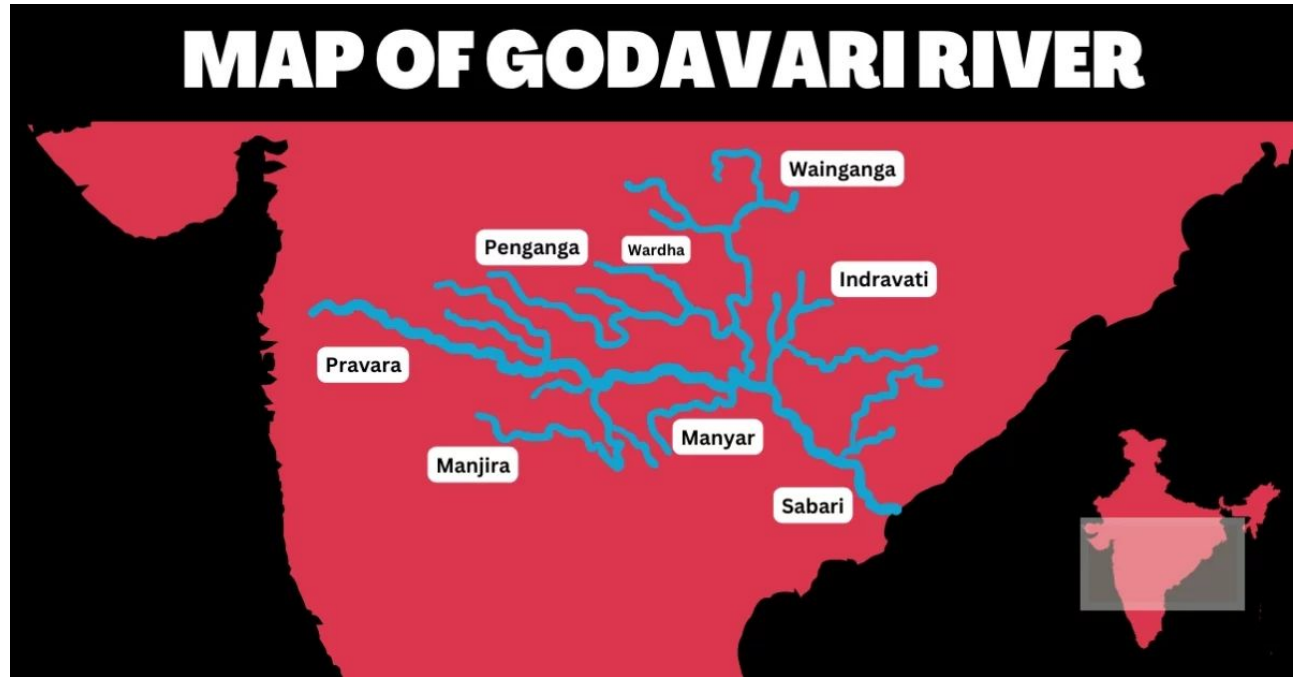
# NARMADA RIVER

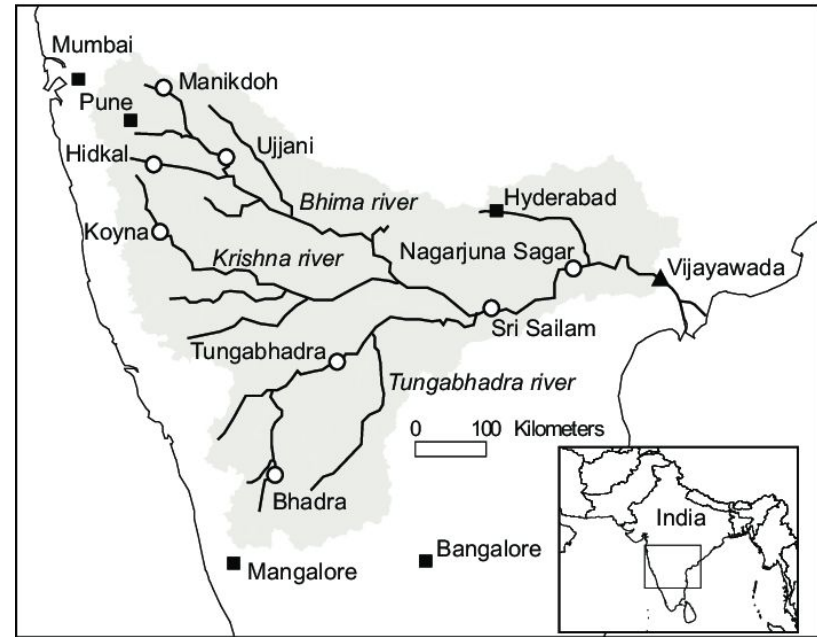


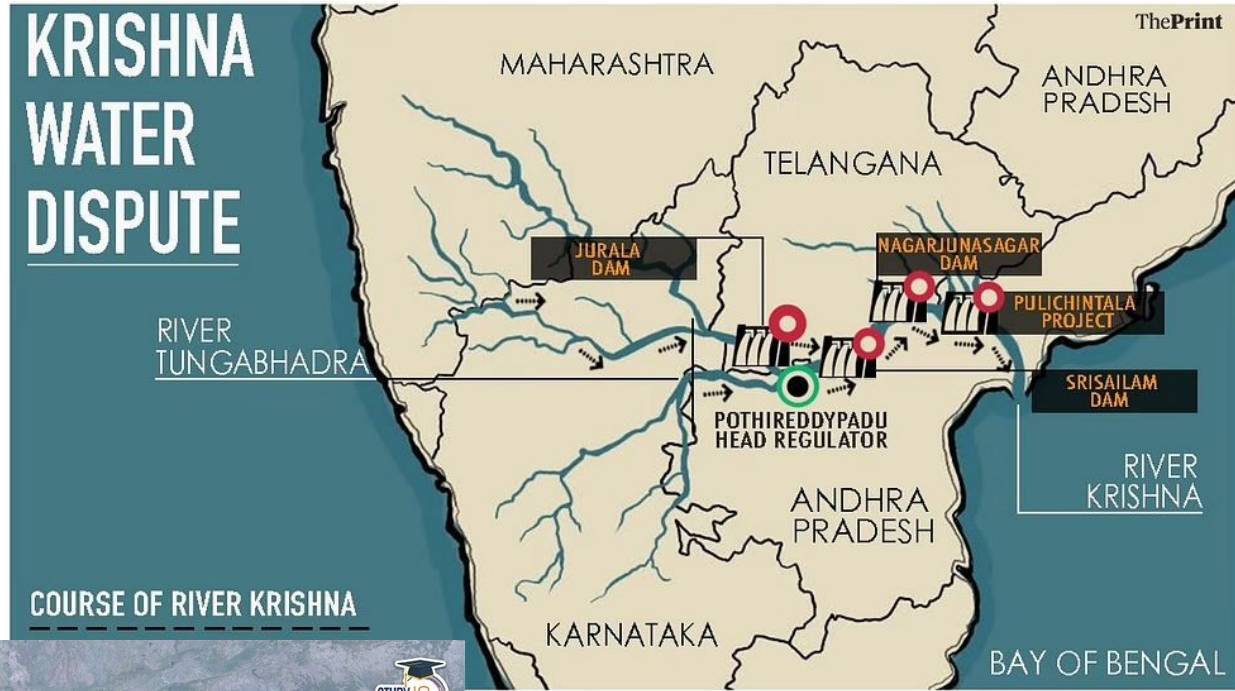


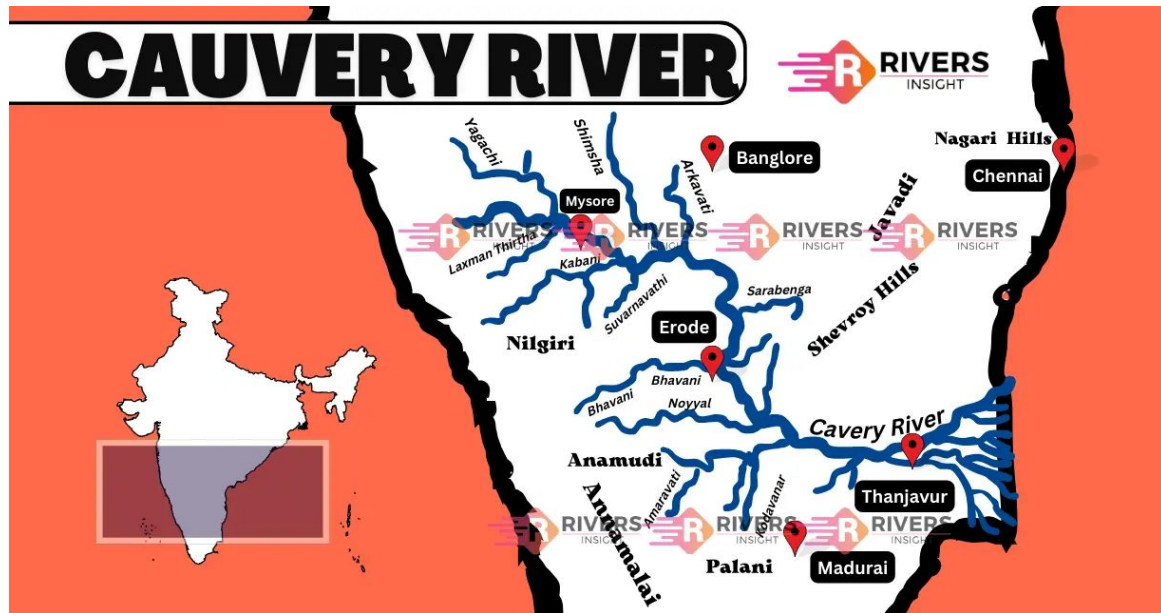




# MAP OF KRISHNA RIVER

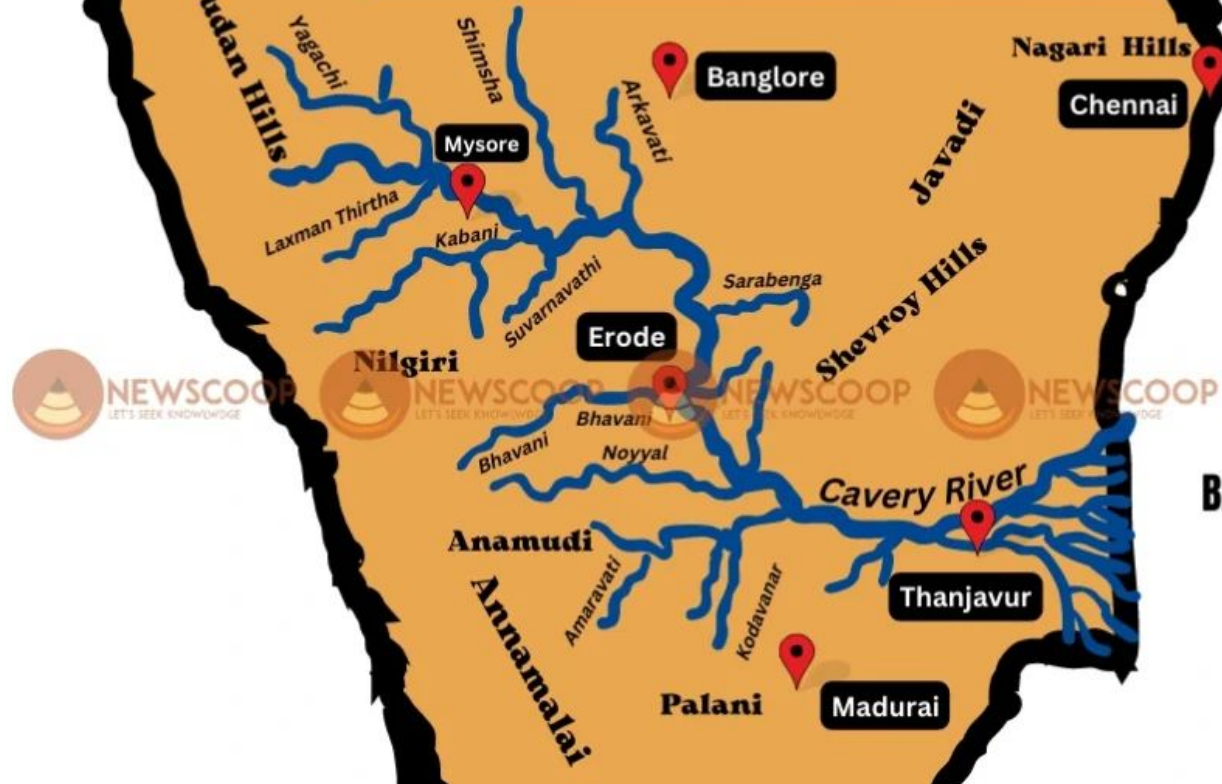








# MAP OF CAUVERY RIVER

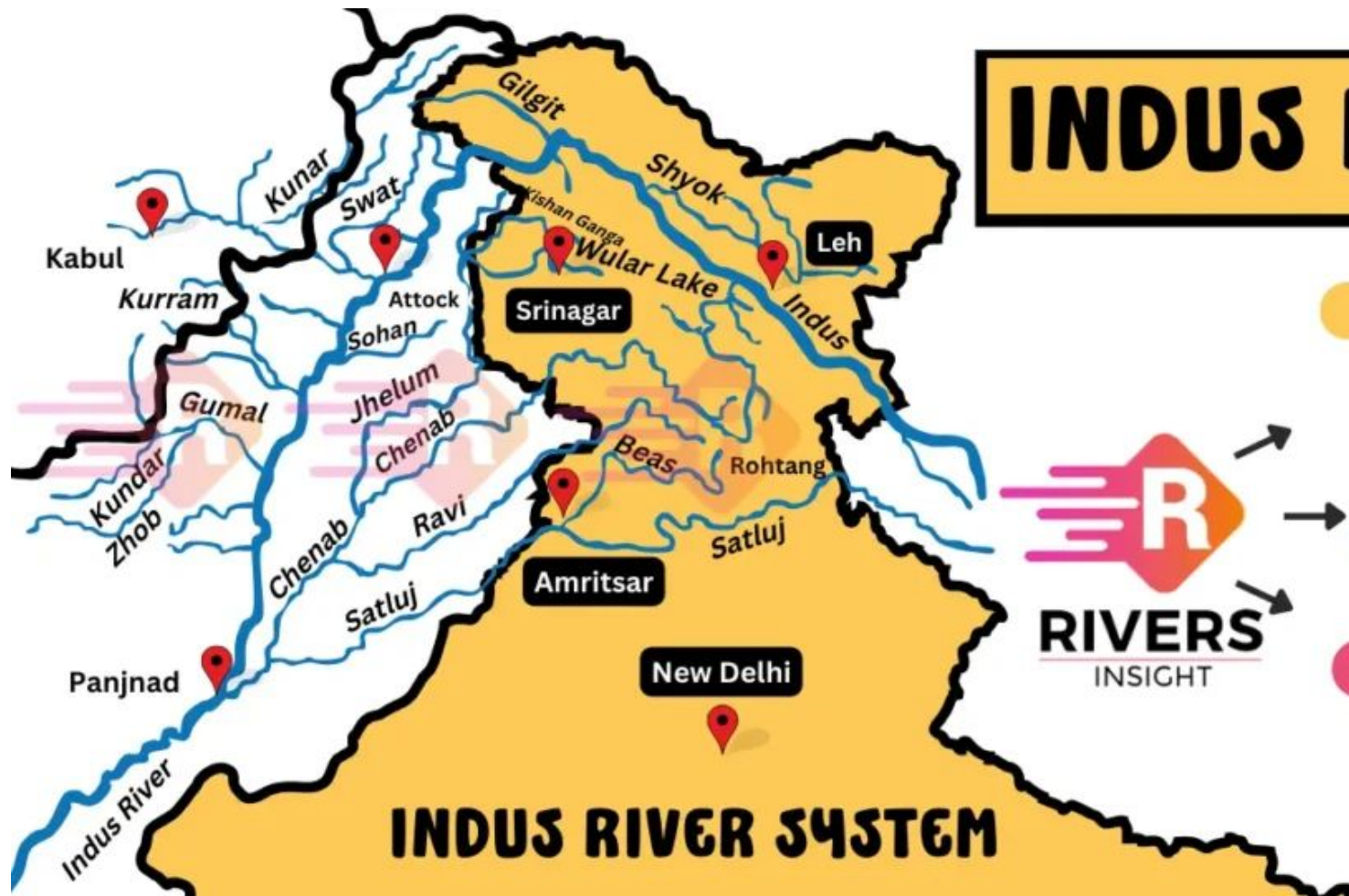
